**"The Diagnostics of Clinical Remediation: Teaching Dental Hygiene Clinical Instructors  
How to Teach"**

#### **COURSE OVERVIEW**

This workshop is designed to assist clinical instructors on recognizing instrumentation techniques that prevent students from achieving clinical competence. This interactive session will review the fundamentals of instrumentation while providing opportunities for instructors to discover other ways to dialogue with students on mastering the complex art of periodontal instrumentation. Process and formative feedback are vital for students to accomplish the basic to advanced skills needed to progress in their clinical environments. This workshop will provide a step-by-step approach to becoming effective clinical instructors. Seasoned instructors will share teaching strategies that facilitated their success in educating even the most difficult students in clinic. Videos will be used to analyze, dissect, and formulate customized clinical instruction that provides positive feedback with concrete intervention.

#### **COURSE OBJECTIVES**

At the conclusion of this course, attendees will be able:

- To identify instrumentation techniques that prevent students from achieving positive outcomes.
- To formulate individualized clinical instruction unique to each student's needs.
- To communicate clinical instruction customized to achieve student competence.

**Lizabeth Spoonts** earned a bachelor's in dental hygiene from Texas Women's University in 1978 and her masters in health education from University of North Texas in 2005.
